## **Exodus – Coming to Know God**

Exodus 5v2 - Pharaoh said, "Who is the LORD...? I do not know the LORD..."

Exodus 6v2-8 - "<u>I am the LORD</u>. I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob... I also established my covenant with them to give them the land of Canaan..."

"Lam the LORD, and I will bring you ● The Exodus ("departure"): chs.1–18 In Egypt out... I will free you from being slaves Growth & Oppression (ch.1) to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with A deliverer is born and called (2–4) mighty acts of judgment." Initial conflict (5–6) & nine plaques! (7–10) Tenth plague, Passover & Exodus (11–13) ⇒ God's mighty power to save travelling At the Red Sea  $(14-15_{v21})$ those in a desperate plight Journey to the Mountain (15<sub>v22</sub>–18) "I will take you as my own people..." ■ The Covenant ("binding treaty"): 19–24 At Mount Sinai (ch.19) ⇒ rescued to be God's people, The 10 commandments  $(20_{v1-21})$ to obey his laws for life, At Mount Sinai Various Laws  $(20_{v22}-23)$ to know Him! 'Sealing' the Covenant (24) "...and I will be your God." **❸ The Tabernacle** ("sacred tent"): **25-40** Instructions (25-31) ⇒ God in the midst. ♣ The Golden Calf affair ♣ (32–34) enthroned as Holy King Construction (35–40) & Indwelling (40<sub>v34-38</sub>)

"Then you will know that <u>Lam the Lorp</u> your God, and I will bring you to the land I swore with uplifted hand to give to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob.

I will give it to you as a possession. <u>Lam the Lorp</u>"
